

Grounds Keeper

Wanuskewin Heritage Park is accepting applications for a temporary full time Grounds Keepers from May through August reporting to the Maintenance Manager. The position will include the following accountabilities:

- Maintains a clean, safe and groomed trail system, road and walkways for all Wanuskewin visitors by consistently completing daily routine procedures
- Ensures each area of the grounds is clean, groomed and free of waste and hazards.
- Provides notification to management of any safety concerns or hazards.
- Advises management of supply needs in advance to ensure inventory is kept at reasonable levels.
- Properly uses equipment in a safe, proper and responsible manner.
- Participates in safety meetings and the development of safety policies.
- Conducts light maintenance duties to equipment and assets to ensure longevity
- Provides notification to management of any potential equipment/asset breakdowns.

Required Qualifications and Experience

Minimum one year experience in this field, with the ability to operate and maintain a variety of equipment. Candidates must possess a valid driver's license and CPIC. This position involves physical labour and the incumbent must be physically capable to handle the duties. WHMIS, First Aid and CPR would be considered an asset. Transportation is a necessity for employment. People with Aboriginal Ancestry will be given preference (HRC-E-91-09) (HRC-E-91-17).
