



## **STF Work-to-Rule Sanctions Update:**

**April 8, 2024**

With the new work-to-rule job action starting on April 8, Wanuskewin wants to reiterate our goal to be as accommodating as possible to educators and schools regarding field trips to Wanuskewin.

**For all field trips that are currently booked at Wanuskewin, we are asking educators to not cancel their bookings yet as we will hold the booking without a deposit.** This way, if sanctions change, educators will still have their booking in place if they want to proceed with their field trip. We will take things week-by-week and handle cancellations and refunds as they come up.

We will still be keeping our same policies in place regarding cancellations due to STF sanctions and/or job action, including the work-to-rule sanctions:

1. All field trip payments this year are due on the booking date to accommodate more flexibility and potential cancellations,
2. We can work to reschedule your booking for the next available date that works for you and us, and will shift any deposits paid to the new date;
3. If you paid a deposit, you can save it as a credit on file to book for later in the school year;
4. If you paid a deposit, you can save it as a credit on file to use in the next school year; or
5. We can refund the full amount, minus processing fees.

Wanuskewin's programs all have connections to the Saskatchewan Curriculum, and we want to welcome your students however possible throughout the remaining school year. If sanctions change to allow schools to bring in presenters, we can come to you!

Inquire about outreach programs where our guides come to your school to deliver a variety of engaging and educational sessions. Another great alternative is our virtual programming where a guide will offer a live 45-60 minute session over a video conferencing platform of your choice
